Curriculum Information

#### Free School Meals

As you may be aware children in years R-2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals, a Government funded initiative. This is however different to Free School Meals. If your child is eligible not only are they entitled to funded meals, the school receives additional funding.

If you receive any of the following benefits then you may be entitled to Free school meals:

- Income Support
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance Child Tax Credit provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit
- Support under part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999
