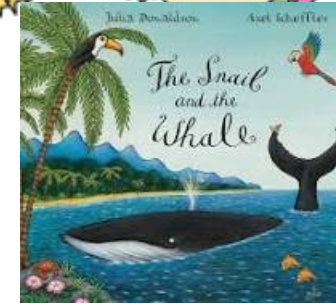


My Learning Log— Under the sea



Vocabulary	Definition
ocean	A huge body of salt water.
rock pool	A small area of sea water contained by the rocks around it
cliff	A steep rock face close to the edge of the sea.
beach	A beach is a narrow, gently sloping strip of land that lies along the edge of an ocean, lake, or river.
physical feature	A feature that has been formed by nature.
human feature	A feature that has been made or changed by humans.
fish	Fish are vertebrates (vertebrates have backbones) that live in water.
fin	The part of a fish's body that helps it balance and move in various directions.
gills	The body part that helps a fish breathe underwater.
habitat	The natural place that something lives. A habitat provides living things with everything they need to survive.
microhabitat	A very small habitat that sea creatures live in like a rock pool.

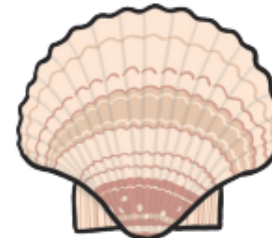

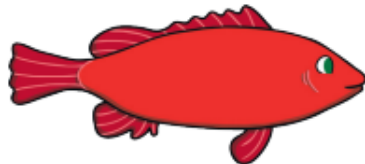

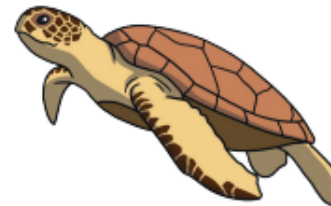
