English

- Develop basic sentence structure.

- Identify important events surrounding the history of flight.

Music

- Sing in tune with a limited pitch range.
- Using musical scales, high notes and low notes in a composition.
- Understand melody through songs, movement and performing pitch shapes on tuned instruments.

Football – dribbling, passing etc.
Dance- Perform simple patterns of movement.

Computing

- Using the internet to research
- Generate their own work, combining text graphics and sounds using PowerPoint.
- Navigating online software.

DT

- Use simple stitches to create a fabric decoration.

How you can help your child at home:

- Listen to your child read daily. To develop comprehension skills, ask questions, encourage your child to locate answers and justify reasons.
- Look at coins and talk about their value. Challenge your child to add up how much things cost when they visit the shop.
- Practise 2, 5 and 10 times tables to encourage fluency.
- Practise number bond recall to 10 and 20.
- Practise spellings for Monday spelling
