I feel happy at school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I love this school, people are really kind and include me in everything.</li><li>• I always have someone to play with.</li><li>• The food is tasty.</li><li>• The teachers are so lovely.</li></ul>
I feel safe at school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If something is wrong the teachers make it better.</li><li>• If I am sad, I know I can go to the adults.</li><li>• I feel safe as I have my friends here.</li></ul>
School teaches me on how to keep safe.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Online safety. The teachers teach us how to be safe in a fun way.</li><li>• Fire drills</li></ul>
I feel safe on the playground	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The teachers are there if something happens.</li><li>• We never are allowed to go outside without an adult out there.</li><li>• Gates are locked to keep us safe.</li><li>• Feel somebody could jump over the fence-<b>Miss Marshall spoke in assembly about how the design of the fence and the height plus other facts make this very, very difficult.</b></li></ul>
I feel confident about approaching a member of staff if I feel unsafe or unhappy at school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I can tell the Lunchtime supervisors also.</li><li>• I feel that I can talk to Miss Marshall, our headteacher also.</li><li>• I can talk to the teachers</li><li>• <b>Follow up work through our PSHE curriculum in class also focus on the range of adult children can talk to.</b></li></ul>
I know what to do in the event of a fire in school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Yes because we have drills.</li><li>• We go outside and line up and even the toilets are checked.</li><li>• When the alarm goes off we all line up quietly, we walk to the playground and a register is done.</li></ul>
I learn about online safety and know how to keep safe when using the internet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• When you go online you should be very careful and follow the rules.</li><li>• It is not funny at all, it is serious, you don't let somebody be mean to you online.</li><li>• There are age limits on games such as Roblox</li></ul>
When I am taken on a school visit I feel safe and well looked after	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We are given a certain teacher/adult to look after us and being in partners is fun.</li><li>• Teachers give us strict instructions.</li></ul>

I understand what bullying means	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Somebody being mean everyday. We have lessons about it in PSHE and they teach us what to do if this happens.</li> <li>• It is constant</li> <li>• Somebody you know that is constantly hurting your feelings.</li> <li>• Being horrible all of the time and being mean.</li> </ul>
I know what to do and who to talk to if I feel I am being bullied or think someone else is.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I would talk to an adult or TAPS Council.</li> <li>• Tell them to stop, walk away and rush to tell the teachers/adults.</li> <li>• I would go to an adult and they would sort it out.</li> </ul>
How much do you enjoy going to school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I love it. The teachers teach me new things and my amazing friends.</li> <li>• I love science activities and seeing my friends. I love talking to the teachers.</li> <li>• I enjoy coming to school. I enjoy Maths, PE and Science.</li> </ul>
At school, are you told when you are doing or have done something well	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They (the adults) always give me a smile and some praise. It makes you happy.</li> <li>• You go to Miss Marshall for a prize.</li> <li>• Teachers say "well done"</li> </ul>
What do you get when you have done something well	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will get a certificate in the Celebration Assembly.</li> <li>• We go and see Miss Marshall for a sticker and a prize.</li> <li>• Dojo points</li> </ul>
Is the behaviour system fair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For the actions you do there are consequences. Prize for good behaviour.</li> <li>• Yes, it as you can go to the calm spaces or just have some time if needed.</li> <li>• People who have been rude also get told off.</li> </ul>
What happens first on the behaviour system	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An adult will speak to them.</li> <li>• You will get told off and the teacher will talk to the other child. Parents can also be spoken to.</li> <li>• An adult will tell you to stop and will talk to you.</li> </ul>
Is there someone you can talk to at school if you have any worries or feel unsafe?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• My friends, the teachers, Teaching Assistants and Lisa (<i>Family Support Worker</i>)</li> <li>• Lunchtime supervisors.</li> <li>• Tell an adult and they will sort it out.</li> <li>• Miss Marshall</li> </ul>
Do you feel that you can talk to an adult if someone is unkind to you?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I would speak to an adult.</li> <li>• TAPS Council (Student Council)</li> <li>• I am shy but I would tell TAPS Council and they will report it and help.</li> <li>• Confident to talk to an adult.</li> </ul>
